

# Watling Vale Travel Clinic



- At the Surgery we only offer a basic travel service so anything more than a package holiday may require more vaccines which would mean going to a Travel Clinic.
- Collect and complete a travel questionnaire from reception and return at least **4 weeks** prior to departure (one form per traveller).
- You will be contacted once we have processed your forms to discuss details and arrange plans/appointments.
- If you have a query relating to boosters or immunisation status leave a message for a nurse to call you.
- Private prescriptions for malaria prophylaxis can be arranged through the nurses at WVMC or at a local Travel Clinic.
- If you have less than 6 weeks until you depart it will be necessary to arrange your travel requirements with a Travel Clinic (details below).
- If you are unsure you can fill out a travel questionnaire and a member of the nursing team will contact you within 2 weeks to inform you that you need to go to a Travel Clinic.

The following vaccinations are available at the Surgery **free of charge**:

Hepatitis A  
Typhoid  
Tetanus  
Diphtheria  
Polio

A local Travel Clinic can offer other vaccines that may be required for your trip  
(Rabies, Japanese Encephalitis, Yellow Fever, Hepatitis B, Meningitis ACWY,  
TB, Tick Bourne Encephalitis
